General Guidelines

Date and Venue

The date of the Digital Drawing will be on **February 14, 2019, 8:00AM-12:00PM**, at F603 Ateneo De Davao University, Jacinto St., Davao City.

Team Composition

Each school is allowed to send a maximum of two (2) participants who are ITE undergraduate students. Participants should be currently enrolled as certified by the ITE Dean. Participants of the Infomercial Contest must not be contestants of other IT Olympiad events. This is an individual competition.

Registration

A **registration fee of P1,500/team** will be collected before the start of the event together with the certification from the ITE Dean.

CONTEST DETAILS

Overview

This is an on-the-spot individual speed digital drawing competition which aims to enhance the creativity and drawing skills of students in conceptualizing and forming characters to express. It generally concerned with the marking of lines and areas of tone onto a digital material, where the accurate representation of the visual world is expressed upon a plane surface.

Working Environment

Each participant will use his own device and a Huion/Wacom Pen Tab will be installed (PenTab will be provided by Huion/Wacom). The device should have an Adobe Photoshop, as the primary software to be used for the contest. Participants, however, are not limited to use other available software that is installed in the assigned PCs.

Conduct

1. This is an individual on-the-spot competition.
2. Each school can have a maximum of two (2) participants.
3. Participants must be pre-registered into the competition and are currently enrolled this second semester, school year 2018-2019, taking up an ITE course.
4. Each participant can submit only one entry (raw <.psd> and jpeg format).
5. Participants shall use Adobe Photoshop as main editing software.
6. Participants shall be provided with a concept of the character to be drawn.
7. Registration of participants will start at 8:00AM and they are required to present their current school Identification Card upon registration.
8. The contest proper will start at exactly 9:00 AM. Participants are given 1 hour to finish their entry. Only the technical staff and participants are allowed inside the assigned venue at the F603 Ateneo De Davao University, Jacinto St., Davao City.
9. Participants are not allowed to interact with each other and shall observe silence the entire duration of the competition.

Scoring of the Contest

Judging of entries will be done by a panel of judges. Entries will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

Creativity 40%

Interpretation and Clarity 30%

Quality of artistic composition 30%

Total 100%

Prizes

First Prize - P 2,000.00; Medal; Certificates

Second Prize – P 1,500.00; Medal; Certificates

Third Prize – P1,000.00; Medal; Certificates

Application of these criteria as to matters of subjectivity shall be at the sole discretion of the judges, whose decisions are final and non-negotiable. Coaches and organizers have no participation into any discussion or correspondence on judges' decisions.
