General Guidelines

Date and Venue

The date of the Infographics Contest will be on **February 14, 2019, 9:00AM-12:00PM**, at F612 Ateneo De Davao University, Jacinto St., Davao City

Participants

Each school is allowed to send a maximum of two (2) participants who are ITE undergraduate students. The participants should be currently enrolled as certified by the ITE Dean. A participant of the Infographics Contest must not be a contestant of other IT Olympiad events. This is an INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION.

Registration

Deadline of registration will be on or before **February 12, 2019, 5:00pm**. Register the contestants and coach to **Mr. Meljohn Aborde <mjaborde@umindanao.edu.ph>** or you may directly pre-register at <https://goo.gl/forms/Mjsll2RNYENV4H3i2>. Late registrants and changes in the names of the contestants after the set deadline will not be entertained.

A **registration fee of P1000/student** will be collected before the start of the event together with the certification from the ITE Dean.

Contest Details

This event aims to challenge the contestants in the area of **data visualization** and **data presentation**. Infographics are posters which can capture and present, at a glance, essential information about complex data. Example infographics can be found on the internet.

Contestants will be given a long article from a newspaper, magazine, or journal. They will extract the salient information and data points from the article and convert them into visually pleasing and easy-to-understand poster.

Infographics posters will be judged according to completeness of information and visual aesthetics. Judges will have a list of questions, to be presented at the end of the contest, that must be addressed by the poster. Correctly addressed questions correspond to points. The aesthetics refer to color harmony, creative use of iconography, typography, and gestalt, and overall impact.

Output format is PNG at least 1024 pixels and at most 4096 pixels wide. It can be any height.

Scoring of the Contest

Judging of entries will be done by a panel of judges. Entries will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

Creativity	40%
Visual Appeal	30%
Relevance	30%
Total	100%

Prizes First Prize - P 3,000.00; Medal; Certificates

Second Prize – P2,000.00; Medal; Certificates

Third Prize – P1,000.00; Medal; Certificates

Application of these criteria as to matters of subjectivity shall be at the sole discretion of the judges, whose decisions are final and non-negotiable. Coaches and organizers have no participation into any discussion or correspondence on judges' decisions.
